B JOB DESCRIPTION

B1 Overall purpose of the job.

To organise and carry out the repair, maintenance and servicing of engines, other components/assemblies and electric equipment of all agriculture tractors. To provide welding, fabrication and repair services of agricultural implements.

Key Responsibilities

- Managing activities of planning and withdrawing machines for planned maintenance, repairing and overhauling.
- Diagnosing and analysing all causes of breakdowns particularly those of operational diligence nature and suggesting remedies.
- Approving requisitions for spare parts, components, accessories, fuel and oil and ensuring optimum levels are maintained in the store and informing the premature failures to the workshop manager
- Overseeing and controlling the receipt and issuing of fuel and spares.
- Co-ordinating field operations and reporting any deviations to relevant managers
- Enforcing disciplinary action and harmony among subordinates.
- Drawing up time tables for periodical service and maintenance of vehicles as per the service schedule.
- Preparing and maintaining accurate records(files) of repairing and servicing history of each vehicle still in use.
- Preparing and maintaining accurate records of tyre management of all vehicles, tractors and heavy machines
- Supervising on-the job training programs to enhance skill development and capacity building.
- Preparing and maintaining routine reports on spares, lubricants and fuel consumption and the running hours of the machines
- Adhering to and enforcing the safety, Health and Environmental policy of the Company
- Performing any other related duties as may be assigned to you by the Manager Agric. Workshop/Management from time to time. Please note that you may be required to work anywhere within the company.

C Knowledge, qualifications & Experience

At least five (5) years supervising a large workshop for agricultural tractors or equivalent plus several years' hands on work experience as a mechanic or technician on agricultural tractors/ Machines/tractors/Light & Heavy vehicles
